MSP is an important process for balancing various interests with environmental concerns to ensure human activities at sea take place in an **efficient, safe and sustainable way**

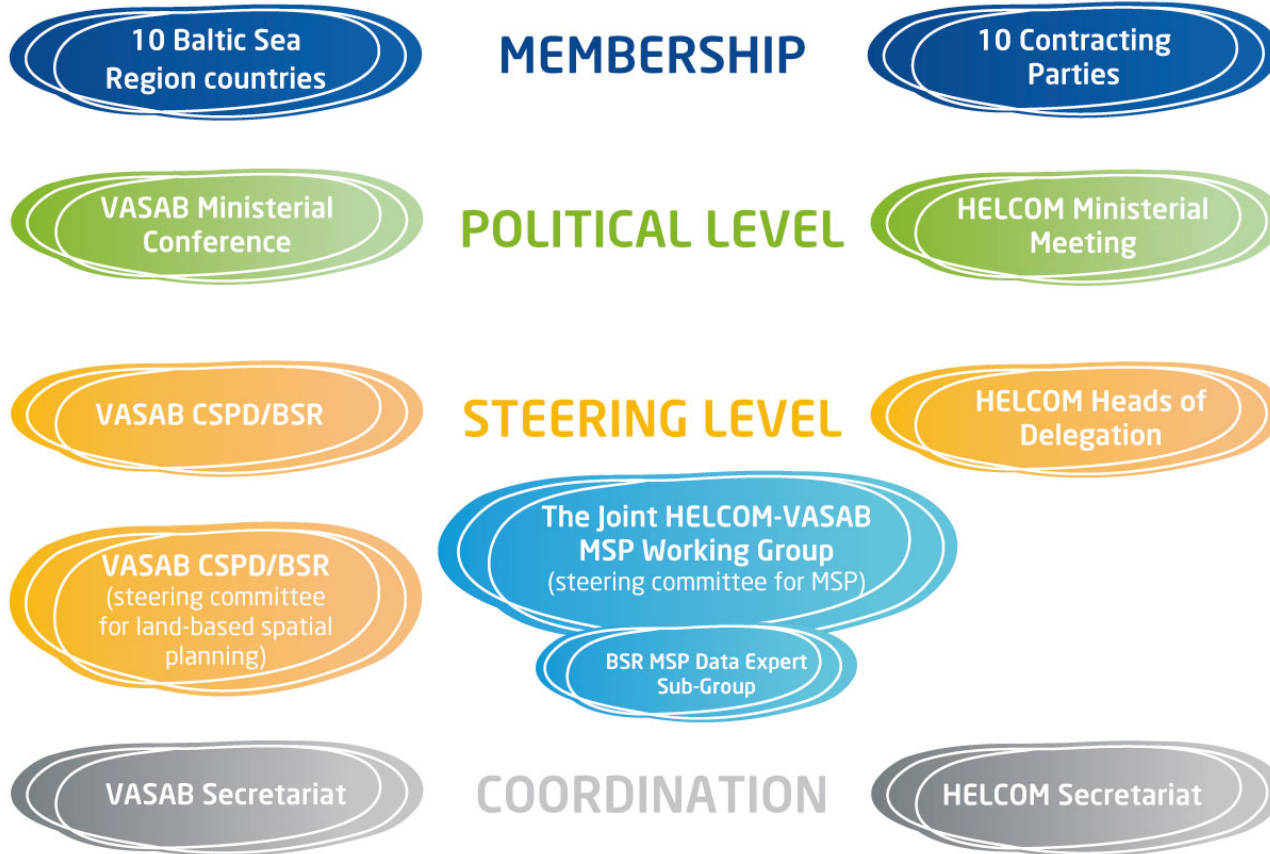

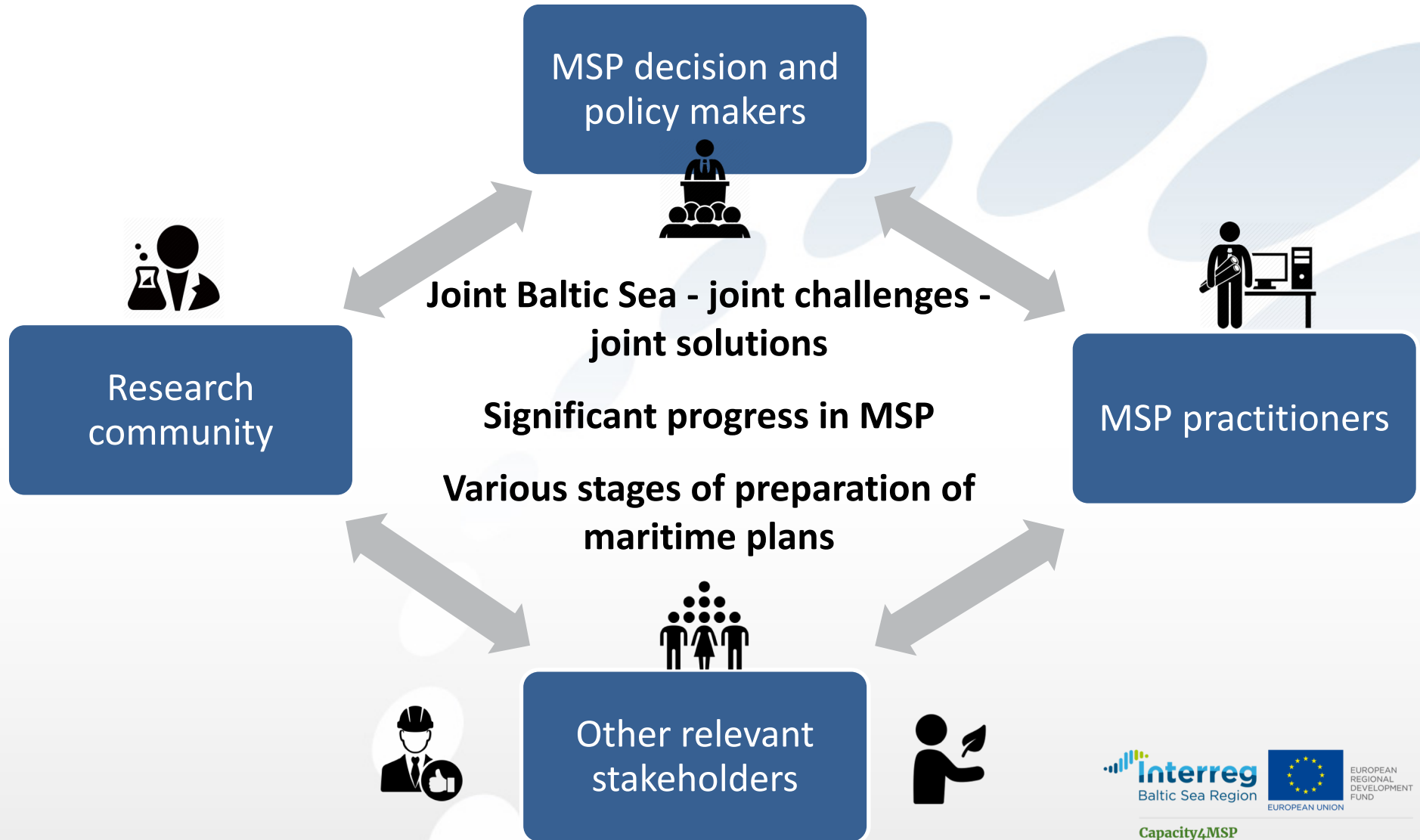
